

# DIPLOMA IN DIABETES

This degree will give you the chance to study within one of Europe's largest diabetes facilities, Diabetes Centre, which offers a unique combination of groundbreaking research and dynamic clinical services. The course provides a wide range of approved, accredited MSc-level modules, combining the most topical and up-to-date thinking around clinical care and research with practical examples of how novel research and evidence-based diabetes care can be applied in real life, clinical settings.

The MSc is six taught modules plus a dissertation. The Postgraduate Diploma (PGDip) is six modules without the dissertation. The Postgraduate Certificate (PGCert) is three modules (the two Clinical Presentation and Management modules plus one option module).

## Core Modules

- Clinical Presentation and Management in Diabetes: Complications and Cardiovascular Disease
- Clinical Presentation and Management in Diabetes: Glycaemic Control, New and Novel Therapies
- Research module (MSc/Diploma only) - choose one from:
  - Fundamentals of Applied Health Research
  - Quantitative Methods in Applied Health Research
  - Qualitative Methods in Applied Health Research

## **Entry Requirements**

The course is open to professionals with relevant first degrees or professional qualifications, and with significant clinical experience in the field. We may also consider applications from professionals with significant experience and/or qualifications in health or social care research practice or management - you may be assessed through an informal interview process.

You will need to provide a written personal statement describing your experience and knowledge of diabetes, and demonstrating enthusiasm for diabetes research and clinical care.
