<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• An MBBS or equivalent degree from an internationally recognised medical school.</li> <li>• At least one year post-qualification clinical experience which should include one year of internship at a hospital and must supply their Certificate of Completion.</li> <li>• Should not be any unexplained gap in their post MBBS career.</li> <li>• Should not have appeared and failed to pass the PLAB examination.</li> <li>• An IELTS score of 6.5, with a minimum of 5.5 in each section.</li> <li>• A reference letter confirming that all previous training in medicine has been in English.</li> <li>• Completed their undergraduate</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• An MBBS or equivalent degree from an internationally recognised medical school.</li> <li>• An MBBS certified by <a href="#">ECFMG</a>,</li> <li>• Three years post MBBS experience including one year of internship at a hospital and must supply their Certificate of Completion.</li> <li>• Should not be any unexplained gap in their post MBBS career.</li> <li>• Should not have appeared and failed to pass the PLAB examination.</li> <li>• Must have some post graduate qualification such as MRCP part one, DNB or Diploma in their own country.</li> <li>• An IELTS score of 7.5, with a minimum of 7.0 in each section.</li> </ul>
